This will be Newport Oregon's 49th Annual **Seafood & Wine Festival**. Along with the fun of the Festival comes the competition of amateur wines.

#### Rules for Entry:

- A complete registration form must be submitted with each wine entry.
- Each entry will consist of: **(1) completed registration form, (1) bottle** (750ml or 375ml dessert/port) **of selected wine to compete, and \$15.00**. Please make payment to the Greater Newport Chamber of Commerce (one check for all bottles will suffice). To pay with credit card please call 541-265-8801 or email [info@newportchamber.org](mailto:info@newportchamber.org) and ask for an invoice.
- The **Variety and Category** should be clearly marked on the front of the bottle as well as on your application.
- Your name should be clearly labeled on the bottom or side of the bottle. Bottles without proper identification will be disqualified. Please feel free to include a specialty label if you have one since the bottle will be displayed at the festival.
- Blind judging will be conducted by a panel of judges. Gold, Silver, and Bronze will be awarded along with one "Best of Show." The winner of Best of Show will receive a hand-made 5-gallon French Oak barrel from Badmotivator Legacy Barrels.
- All wines that are awarded in the previously listed classifications will be mailed a certificate and corresponding ribbon.
- Results of the competition will be mailed to all participants by March 1st.
- **Please do not enter wines that have been previously judged in this competition.**
- Remember each entry must have a complete registration form. All entries must be received by the Greater Newport Chamber of Commerce no later than **January 30, 2026**, and to a Drop Site NO LATER THAN **January 26, 2026**.
