## AGATE BEACH

Visit Yaquina Head Lighthouse and explore tide pools, view seabird nesting areas, and sweeping coastal scenes. Agate Beach Wayside offers beach access, picnic spots, and a front-row seat to local surfing. Nearby, you'll find trails, bike rentals, and other easy-to-reach amenities along Highway 101.

## NYE BEACH

This quaint seaside district features ocean view lodging, unique boutiques, art galleries, and a wide range of restaurants. Catch a performance at the Performing Arts Center or view rotating exhibits at the free-to-visit Visual Arts Center. Stroll the beach, fly a kite, or stop by the nearby skate park and playground.

## CITY CENTER – DECO DISTRICT

In the heart of Newport, City Center features distinctive Art Deco architecture inspired by the Yaquina Bay Bridge, along with shopping, dining, and lodging. Shop the annual Newport Farmer's Market from March to November. Learn about local history at the Burrows House Museum, take a swim or join a fitness class at the Recreation Center, or stop by the library for a good beach read.

## BAYFRONT

Newport's Historic Bayfront is home to Oregon's largest commercial fishing fleet. Stroll Bay Boulevard, browse shops and galleries, enjoy fresh seafood, or try your hand at crabbing. Attractions include wildlife viewing boat tours, sea lion's lounging on the docks, Ripley's Believe It or Not, and more. For a scenic break, head to Yaquina Bay State Park for beach access, picnic areas, and a historic lighthouse.

## SOUTH BEACH

South Beach is home to the Oregon Coast Aquarium, ranked among the best in the nation, and the Hatfield Marine Science Center, where hands-on exhibits bring ocean science to life. Blow your own glass float, enjoy a hands-on craft workshop, or explore shops in Aquarium Village. With RV parks, trail access, birdwatching, surfing, charter fishing, and dining, South Beach has so much to offer every explorer.
